US Grant Applications

Cyd West, Sias Board President, and Patrice Reynolds, volunteer for fundraising and recruitment, have submitted a grant application to the UN Embassy in Beijing for funding that would support the operation and expansion of the World Academy at Sias Campus. A response from China is expected by early July. Thank you Cyd and Patrice!



A second proposal will be submitted to the US Embassy in Dhaka, Bangladesh. Mandy Tao and Jerrie met with Embassy staff in Dhaka in April to discuss details. The proposal will be submitted by the end of June, with an expected late summer response.
